Dear Harbour Mooring Holders and Visitors,

Welcome to Saundersfoot Harbour's 2021 season. With the COVID restrictions cautiously being lifted by Welsh Government, it is hoped that we will have a more complete season for access to the water than last year and equally we have our fingers crossed for some good weather.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our mooring holders for their support during this difficult period. Like all businesses in Pembrokeshire and Wales, we have had some challenges over the last 12 months, however, we are well placed with our retained staff to reopen for the coming season.

Vessels are now being relocated to their Harbour moorings and I would be most grateful if Mooring Holders could contact the Harbour Master to arrange their boat launch, if you have not already done so, as I would like to see the Harbour hard standing and car park cleared of boats as soon as possible.

As some of you may already be aware, the Harbour Office has now relocated to its new facilities directly overlooking Glen Beach within the new Marine Centre of Excellence, which also offers new facilities soon to open such as the Café, Chandlery, and Water Sports Centre.

It will be business as usual for the Harbour team, as they will still be patrolling the harbour and assisting with visitor enquiries. However, new to the Harbour this year will be a yellow and white cabin to be located on the slipway for the summer season as an operation base for the Harbour team when water is on the slip.

Ongoing Harbour developments:

Construction on the Harbour's ambitious Phase 2 developments has not stopped over the past year, however COVID has impacted the completion timeline and, therefore, we are still some months off from opening the remaining two developments of Ocean Square and the Heritage Schooner, which will have some impact on car parking and access to the National Events Deck for the next few months. It is expected that the completion date will be August, however, it is hoped that part of the Ocean Square development i.e., the plaza and the excellent array of new shops will begin to open from early to mid-May.

I would urge all who visit the Harbour to keep up to date with the Harbour website as there will be further useful information posted for mooring holders and visitors, and would like to ask visitors to continue following the Welsh Government's COVID guidelines at all times.

Finally, I would like to say, on behalf of the Harbour Commissioners and Harbour team, we look forward to meeting old friends, as well as welcoming new visitors to the Harbour.
