

COMMERCIAL PASSENGER TRIPPING MOORING VACANCY

The Trust Port of Saundersfoot Harbour is looking to award one new commercial passenger tripping mooring and operator licence to a suitable operator.

The successful operator will be selected on the basis of a sound business plan that demonstrates they can operate professionally and sustainably throughout the summer period, whilst complementing the Ports inclusive objectives by offering suitable adaptive facilities abroad their vessel and demonstrate appropriate accessibility for all along with safe and efficient passenger loading processes.

Equally the Commissioners are looking for an operator who understands the need to work in partnership with the Harbour Team in developing a successful tourism visitor attraction that will complement the new facilities based on the harbour following the completion of phase two of the Ports development strategy, as well as understand the importance of offering a quality family friendly service.

The allocated mooring will be located within the harbour, the optional extra of a wall mooring for a tender and an outer harbour swing mooring shall also be available.

The mooring and commercial operator's licence will be offered annually providing that you have operated satisfactorily with the above conditions and in accordance with our Harbour regulations. This allocation is offered on the basis that the sole business offering is limited to passenger pleasure sightseeing activities only; any fishing activities will not be permitted.

All interested parties are invited to submit a business plan to the Trust Port's Harbour Master either by post or via email: harbourmaster@saundersfootharbour.co.uk no later than Monday 17th February 2025 at 12:00pm, any applications after this time may not be considered.

The commercial mooring and operator's licence are awarded to a named individual and not a company or partnership, in which the mooring cannot be transferred / sublet or sold. Equally it would be expected that the named operator is on site at the Harbour or within the nearby vicinity for the majority of the vessels operational period and would be required to play a principal role in the day-to-day management and operation of the vessel.
